

How do AUS teachers and principals use MAP Growth scores?

Teachers, coaches and interventionists can use the score to inform instruction, personalize learning, and monitor the growth of individual students.

Specifically in high school, MAP scores are used as one of four criteria students have to meet to be considered for the Honors and Accelerated programs. Additionally, using the MAP Growth college preparedness benchmarks helps educators determine which students are classified as on-track for college with a likelihood of scoring well on the SAT.

Principals and administrators can use the scores to see the performance and progress of a class, grade level, or the entire school.
